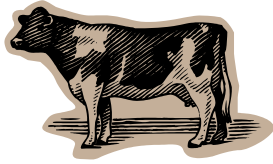

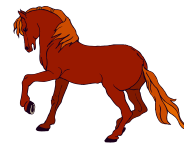


Social Report
